If none of these conditions apply, **no form is required**. Plants should include the name and care instructions if known. The Form is also helpful to let everyone know who the artist is. We hope everyone will bring something to be sold. In any case, come with pockets full of silver and don't be outbid!!

Everyone attending will be assigned a number which will be your anonymous bidding number. There will be no minimum bids on any item unless specifically requested by the donor. The bid increment will be fifty cents (\$.50). In case of unsold items, the donor may elect to have the item returned.
